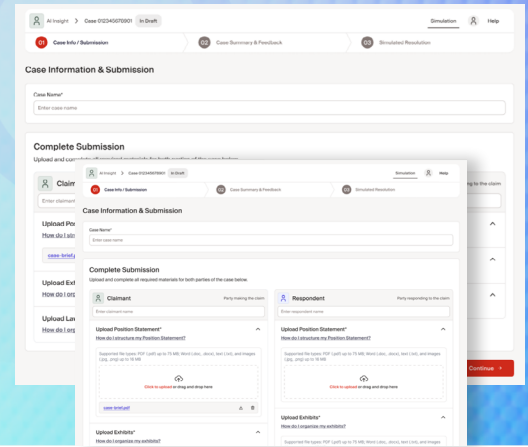

Why It Matters

Escalating a dispute is a strategic — and often costly — decision.

Before moving forward, legal teams often need to understand:

- How would a neutral arbitrator assess the facts and legal arguments of this case?
- Where are the strengths and vulnerabilities in our position?
- What issues may drive risk or settlement?
- Is arbitration, mediation, litigation, or early resolution the right path?

What Makes It Different?

- **Experience-Informed Structure:** The Resolution Simulator, powered by the AAA's AI Arbitrator, models how an arbitrator might analyze a dispute or decide a case.
- **Neutral by Design:** The system evaluates the materials a single party submits for both sides of the dispute through a balanced, analytical lens.

- **Transparent and User-Validated:** Users review and provide feedback on extracted and summarized claims and issues before analysis is finalized.
- **Responsible & Governed AI:** The Resolution Simulator is developed under the AAA's AI governance frameworks and institutional oversight.

How It Works

- Upload claims, counterclaims, and supporting materials (evidence and law)
- Review and validate AI-identified issues and summaries
- Receive structured case analysis with record citations
- Generate a simulated decision illustrating how an arbitrator might reason through the dispute
