Notice: To begin the arbitration process, you must provide the AAA a copy of this completed form as well as:

- A clear, legible copy of the contract containing the parties' agreement to arbitrate disputes (Please note: Parties located in California or New Jersey must submit to AAA the entire contract that contains the agreement to arbitrate);
- The proper filing fee (filing fee information is noted above and in the Costs of Arbitration section of the Consumer Arbitration Fee Schedule, which can be found at www.adr.org); and
- A copy of the court order, if arbitration is court-ordered.

Also send a copy of the completed form and any attachments to all parties and retain a copy of the form for your records.

To file online, visit <u>www.adr.org</u> and click on File a Case and follow directions. To avoid the creation of duplicate filings, please submit the filing documents and payment at the same time. When filing electronically, no hard copies are required.
